UN LUGAR, SE LLAMA CASA – Proyecto #2

En este proyecto, tú vas a hacer un mapa de tu pueblo/ciudad **ideal**. En este mapa, tú vas a dibujar tu casa/apartamento Y las calles alrededor de tu pueblo/ciudad. Necesitas mostrarme las cosas que están en tu casa/apartamento y también los lugares en tu pueblo/ciudad. Por eso, tú debes usar tu lista de vocabulario.

*In this project, you are going to make a map (diagram) of your **ideal** town or city. In this map (diagram) you are going to draw your house/apartment AND the streets around your **ideal** town/city. You need to show me the things in your house/apartment and also the places in your town/city. For this, you should use your vocabulary list.*

PROCESS

1. Decide what your ideal house and town/city looks like. What amenities does your house have? What places do you have in your town/city that make it unique and a perfect place to live? What is the overall layout of your house, and town/city (where are things located in relation to one another)?

Step One: Draw and label a minimum of 12 items in your house

-Viewers should be able to see inside of your house, as if the roof was missing, or as if one whole side of the house was gone

Step Two: Draw and label a minimum of 8 places in your town/city

Step Three: Label a minimum of 10 streets in Spanish (calle Toro, calle Perro)

---First draft your home and town/city on a piece of paper. After it has been checked by a teacher, transfer the map/diagram to a larger piece of paper provided (you may use poster board, make a three-D model etc.).

---Final draft must entirely be in Spanish.

---Final draft must be neat (you must use a ruler!!!) and colorful.

2. **OPTION ONE:** Answer questions about your home and ideal town or city. Choose a minimum of 15 questions to answer in complete Spanish sentences in regards to your project.

3. ¿Hay un garaje cerca de tu casa?
4. ¿Qué cosas están en tu cocina?
5. ¿Compartes un dormitorio con tu hermano/a?
6. ¿Hay una biblioteca en tu pueblo/ciudad?
7. ¿Cuántas gasolineras están en tu pueblo/ciudad?
8. ¿Hay una librería en tu pueblo/ciudad?
9. ¿Cuántas casas están en tu calle?
10. ¿Cuándo compras comida, adónde vas?
11. ¿Dónde está tu casa/apartamento?
12. ¿Dónde está la casa de tu amigo/a?
13. ¿Dónde está el correo?
14. ¿En que calle, hay una tienda?
15. ¿Dónde está el hospital?
16. ¿Dónde está tu restaurante favorito?
17. ¿Hay una escuela en tu pueblo/ciudad?
18. ¿Hay un parque en tu pueblo/ciudad?
19. ¿Vas al supermercado para comprar comida?
20. ¿Vas a la biblioteca para estudiar?

---Your final answers to the questions should be written (typed) in complete Spanish sentences and submitted with your final map/diagram.

2. **OPTION TWO:** In a paragraph (minimum of 15 complete Spanish sentences) tell me about your house and your ideal town/city. For example: What's inside your house? On what streets are different stores located? Where do you go to buy certain things?

1. You must use the verb **estar** 3 times.
2. You must use the expression **hay** 3 times.
3. You must use the verb **ir** 3 times.
4. You must use at least 10 different **vocabulary words**.

---Your final paragraph should be written (typed) in complete Spanish sentences and submitted with your final map/diagram.
